




























ORGANIZATIONAL ACHIEVEMENTS IN FY 2016

- Expanded independance day coverage to a level allowing an entire episode of Hingham Happenings to be dedicated to this one day's events
- Completed the first draft of a long term strategic plan for HCAM
- Purchased and erected a new news set for the HCAM studio
- Provided holiday photos to more than 115 families/groups at Hingham's annual Christmas in the Square event.
- Updated HCAM's Policies & Procedures & Employee handbook & updated job descriptions
- Hired an architect to plan how to incorporate 1,475 square feet to HCAM's floor plan and improve overall efficiency of space at HCAM
- Broke ground on construction/expansion at HCAM's Pond Park studio in South Hingham. Added almost 60% additional space and alleviated several pain points in our existing facility















- Adapted HCAM's Christmas in the Square presence for the first annual Summerfest.
- Worked with the Hingham Cable Advisory Committee to consolidate the three grant agreements which outline HCAM's charge and relationship to/with the Town of Hingham.
- Upgraded recording and monitoring equipment was installed in the Selectmen's hearing room
- Long-term programming archival hardware was purchased and integrated at HCAM's studios
- Kicked off the franchise renewal process by holding a very well attended "Ascertainment Hearing" Hingham Town Hall.
- Transitioned all HCAM funds to Hingham Institution for Savings
- Coordinated full (multicam) coverage of HHS Girls Basketball team through the divisional finals.
- Created an After School Video Club at Hingham Middle School
- Improved HCAM's office IT infrastructure improving workflow and increase our production efficiency

- Performed several upgrades to HCAM's set, prop, and equipment storage as well as security.
- Consolidated signal processing equipment for simplicity and transfer to HD when possible
- Internship program expanded to accommodate multiple interns.
 Expanded to allow upto 3 interns
- Added Live-tweeting to HCAM's traditional coverage of Hingham's Annual Town Meeting
- Worked with the Hingham Zoning and Planning Boards to reclassify HCAM's zoning and proposed new language for the zone.
- Two meeting rooms in Hingham town hall's 3rd floor were furnished with A/V projectors and speakers for presentation and video capture
- Joined Barnes & Noble as a presenting sponsor at "Maker Faire 2016". Many 'makers' attended and got involved
- Released a new HCAM website template transitioning to an easier way to navigate interface
- Hosted several events for the South Shore Independent Filmmakers Meetup group















- Was invited by the South Shore Chamber of Commerce to appear at their Innovation Showcase; sharing the opportunities available locally in Community Media
- Hosted the Hingham Business Council in HCAM-TV's studio for their monthly meeting
- Partnered with our local state level legislators and MassAccess to testify in favor of legislation that would bring HD, OnDemand & Electronic Programming Guide functionality to HCAM
- HCAM Executive Director; Eric Dresser recognized for leadership by Cape & Plymouth Magazine as one of 2016's "40 Under 40"
- Honored fallen marine;
 Christopher Orlando through providing tasteful coverage of the funeral held at St. Paul's Church
- Expanded outreach templates allowing for additional outreach opportunities to attract interns, members and HCAM viewers
- Ran 6 week after school programs in 2 of 4 Hingham elementary schools serving roughly 20 students and inspiring interest in a new hobby

















HCAM EDUCATIONAL ACCESS PROGRAMMING


Below are totals and photos from our Educational Access programming in 2016.




